


## Condoms
























#### 1021 Condom Sampler packs distributed amongst MSM in Brighton and Hove

95% of respondents reported an increase in knowledge of the types of condoms available, and 91% reported an increase in the confidence in choosing a condom that they will enjoy using.

66% of users also felt that if they had a supply of their chosen condom it would increase the likelihood that they use one when they had sex in the future.

88% of respondents rated the campaign as either good or excellent.

### **CONDOM QUIZ – YOUR RESULT**

#### You told us:

- · You wanted to get more feeling from your condoms.
- · Your condoms feel loose (so you probably need a smaller condom).
- And they irritate the skin (which suggests an allergy to latex).

#### Our recommendation

You might feel a real difference if you try latex-free condoms that are extra thin. Thinner condoms should give you more feeling. Studies show they are no more likely to break than thicker ones (including during anal sex).

There are no latex-free condoms in a smaller size but you can get condoms that are smaller but are made of latex. Brands such as Pasante, Mates and Durex provide different options you could try.
