

A quarter of the public seem to feel their employer should have to tell them if their colleague is living with HIVⁱ








'All healthcare workers should receive training, so they know up to date information on HIV in the UK today'







Figure 11. Experiences of stigma in healthcare settings by how recently the experience occurred




Figure 13. Experiences of stigma in dental care, by how recently the experience occurred



 - Additional Funding.






