THE ECHO CHAMBER EFFECT



ideas inside the chamber resonate so that the people inside begin to believe it's the predominate world view even if they are the ones actually on the fringe while conflicting ideas never make it into the chamber or are ignored causing them to die



Positive voices 2022

45% of people living with HIV (PLWHIV) felt ashamed of their HIV status

1 in 3 (32%) PLWHIV reported low selfesteem due to their status

1 in 7 (13.7%) patients had worried about being treated differently when accr healthcare because of their HIV st

What Is Prejudice?

Prejudice can be conscious or unconscious and involves stereotypes, prejudgments, and beliefs (which are usually negative) about a group of people. These beliefs can be based on: race, sex, gender, religion, culture, disability, sexuality, etc.

- Mandatory pre-procedure
- Clinical justification for testing even if patient perceive risk
- Nudge towards HIV screening
