Background to Mission Zero

- Calderdale West Yorkshire, between Leeds and Manchester, a mix of rural and urban areas
- Work started in late 2023 with the aim of signing up to Fast Track Cities
- Decided to start work ahead of formally signing up
- A 12-month partnership approach focussed on TB and hepatitis C, as well as HIV
- Led by The Brunswick Centre with a range of partners
- Launched in May 2024





What is Mission Zero?

AIMS

 Ending new HIV, TB and viral hepatitis transmissions, stopping preventable deaths and eliminating associated discrimination and stigma in Calderdale by 2030

OBJECTIVES

- Increase awareness and knowledge of HIV, TB, and viral hepatitis in Calderdale
- Improve access to testing, treatment, and care services
- Reduce stigma




